VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY

IN RE: Community Service in Lieu of Fines and Costs pursuant to Virginia Code Section §19.2-354(C).

Pursuant to Virginia Code Section §19.2-354(C), this Court provides an option to any person upon whom a fine and costs have been imposed to discharge all or part of the fine or costs by earning credits for the performance of community service work before or after imprisonment. This option is applicable only to court-assessed fines and costs.

- 1. All community service work must be performed in Montgomery County, Virginia.
- 2. The rate or remuneration shall match the minimum wage on the date the individual enters into the community service program. The minimum wage is set by the United Stated Department of Labor's Wage and Hour Division as published at https://www.dol.gov/general/topic/wages/minimumwage

The total number of hours completed shall be multiplied by the minimum wage hourly rate and the resulting amount shall be credited against the total amount of fines and costs owed by the individual in this Court.

- 3. All community service work performed pursuant to this program shall be under the sole auspices of this Court and Adult Probation and Parole. Adult Probation and Parole have sole authority to determine the location where the community service is performed, the number of hours satisfactorily performed, and all terms and conditions of this program.
- 4. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this program, including the written proposal, shall result in removal from the program.
- 5. Completed community service hours pursuant to this program may be applied only to fines and costs owed by the participant in the Montgomery County Circuit Court.
- 6. The Court reserves the right to remove a participant from the program.

7. The Court reserves the right to revise and amend the terms and conditions of the program at any time.
